do make and constitute this my last
Will and Testament hereby revoking any
former Wills I may have made of
Adam Biney

be paid out of my estate

Item 2nd
I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
all my property including all my real
estate or interest therein I may have
situate in Adams County Indiana - rights
credits & choses in action and all my
personal property of whatever kind

Item 3rd

It is my will that my said wife
Dianah Bly pay my debts out of my
property so bequeathed to her and I hereby
appoint her sole executrix without
bond to settle my affairs and stipulate
in this my last Will that she be not
required to take out letters testamentary
unless it should become necessary to
defend her rights herein and in that
case that she be granted unto her
without bond for the faithful performance
of her duties as such executrix
