I, Frederick W. Bahr, of Adams County, Indiana, being of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby make and publish this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all other will by me heretofore made.

Item 1.

It is my will that all my just debt, including expenses of my last sickness and funeral expenses, be paid out of my estate as soon after my death as practicable.

Item 2.

and hereunto and devise to my two sons Herman Bahr and Louis Bahr my ninety (90) acre farm, the same being the west half of the South west quarter of section six (6) and also the west half of the west half of the north west east quarter of said South west quarter of said section six (6) all in township 28 north of range 15 east in Adams County, Indiana, together with all my personal property and machinery and money and credits that I may be the owner of at my death, My said two sons Herman Bahr and Louis Bahr shall, in consideration thereof, pay all the expenses of my last funeral, and they shall further pay, in consideration of the above bequest, to my two sons Henry Bahr and William Bahr and to my daughter Minna Conrad, wife of Ernst Conrad, each the sum of three hundred (\$300⁰⁰) dollars to be paid within one year after my death and without interest.
