## Last Will and Testament of Alexander Baldo

Last Will and Testament  
 I Alexander Baldo of said County of Adams  
 County Indiana, being of sound mind and body  
 make this my last Will and Testament.

My children having received from me during  
 my life to this date the following sums of money &  
 trust which is now due and due to me  
 Daniel P. Baldo Fifty Five Hundred Forty four (\$5764)  
 George W. Baldo Five Thousand One Hundred Thirty four (\$5134)  
 Otto Baldo Twenty Two Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$2280)  
 Rufina W. Lindsey Three Thousand Dollars (\$3000) and I  
 give my purpose to give to each of these children the  
 sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3000) & have this day  
 accepted notes from Daniel P. Baldo, George W. Baldo and  
 Otto Baldo for the excess of three thousand of these  
 indebtedness to me to paid or accounted for out of my  
 estate.

Item 2. I desire all my just debt be paid and  
 from my estate to be bought a suitable monument  
 to be placed at my grave costing not less than \$200.00

Item 3. After the above items are satisfied I give and  
 bequeath to my children above named my entire estate to be  
 divided equally among them.

Item 3. I hereby appoint Daniel P. Baldo, George W. Baldo, Otto  
 Baldo and Rufina W. Lindsey to be executors of this last will.

In testimony of which I have hereunto set my hand  
 and declare this to be my last will and Testament, this  
 25th day of August, 1911.
