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LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

MINA E. BOLLENBACHER

I, the undersigned, Mina E. Bollenbacher, residing in Adams County, Indiana and being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish, and declare the following to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all wills by me heretofore made.

ITEM ONE

I hereby direct my Executors to settle my estate as promptly as in their discretion may appear advisable in consonance with a maximum realization from the assets of my estate. In connection with such settlement, I direct my Executors to pay all my just debts, funeral expenses, and cost of administration first out of my estate.

ITEM TWO

I bequeath the old family Bible which I own to my daughter, Opal P. Luginbill. I, further, bequeath my 22-caliber rifle to my grandson, Jerry Bollenbacher.

ITEM THREE

I direct my Executors to sell all the rest and residue of my property, real and personal, and to distribute all said property, or the proceeds thereof to my children, share and share alike, to-wit; Francis A. Bollenbacher, Albert R. Bollenbacher, Goldia M. Luginbill, Opal P. Luginbill, Wilma R. Alt, and William E. Bollenbacher. If any of my said children should predecease me and have a child or children living at my death, I give the share of such deceased child to the child or children of the child of mine so deceased. But if any of my said children should predecease me and have no child or children living at my death, the number of shares shall be reduced accordingly.

ITEM FOUR

I give to my Executors full power and authority to sell all or any part of my real estate or personal property at public or private sale as they may deem advisable and to execute and deliver deeds or other instruments necessary to transfer title thereto, all without the order of any court as to appraisal, notice, report, or confirmation or any other matter related to such sales

ITEM FIVE

I hereby appoint my son, Francis A. Bollenbacher and my daughter, Opal P. Luginbill, as co-executors of this my last will and testament. My Executors shall not be required to furnish bond in excess of the minimum allowed by law.
