Will of Abraham Bollman.

In the name of the Benevolent Father of all
 I, Abraham Bollman being of sound mind
 and publish this my last will and testament
 of such property as a kind providence has
 me to own, as follows, to wit:

1st. I give and bequeath to my wife Christiana Bollman
 all the real estate I now own to have and to hold the
 same during her natural life, giving her hereby a full
 estate in all said Real Estate, in lieu of the portion
 thereof she would be entitled to by law: I further give
 my said wife all my household and Kitchen furniture
 all provisions for family use on hand and out cow
 Whitley.

2. The residue of my personal estate I direct my
 executor to sell at public auction for cash or upon
 such time as he may deem best:

3. I direct my executor to collect all debts and
 due my estate and pay all debts due from my estate
 last expenses of sickness and funeral, and divide
 balance of money in his hands as follows, 1st to my
 wife aforesaid he shall give one third and the
 mainity two thirds he shall divide among my children
 share and share alike

4th. After the determination of the life estate herein
 also in my real estate to my said wife said real estate
 shall belong in fee simple to my said children now
 living, share and share alike.

5. I hereby appoint my son Samuel B. Bollman
 executor of this my last will and testament
 Abraham ^{made} Bollman

Bado each signed their names to the same as subscribing witnesses, in his presence, and at his request and in the presence of each other.
