In the name of our Rouseful Father of all,
 in account of the uncertainty of life and the
 certainty of death, I, Peter Boze of Adams County
 Indiana and by occupation a farmer make this my
 last will and hereby revoke all former wills by me made.
 It is my will that after my death, all of my debts
 and bills here and general expenses be first paid out of
 my Estate, and it is further my will that the person
 or persons taking care of me during any sickness shall
 also receive reasonable pay for so doing. Then it is
 my will that after my death and the above mentioned
 condition having been complied with that my Son
 Stephen Wesley Boze shall receive fifty dollars out of
 my Estate and it is further my will that the remainder
 of my property both Real ^{and} ~~and~~ personal property be equally
 divided between each of my children or their children, should
 the remainder of my children or their children, should
 my children die before I do, it is my will that

 equal with my children, except she shall also have
 a bed and bed clothes for a good bed.
