I Augustus A. Brodbeck of the County of Adams
State of Indiana being of sound mind and disposing
memory, do make and publish this as my last will
and testament, hereby revoking all former wills of me
made.

1st. It is my will that all my just debts to be paid
and all legal charges out of my personal estate
paying my just debts out of my personal estate
absolutely to my wife Annie C. Brodbeck after
1st. I give and devise to my wife Annie C.
Brodbeck all the real estate I may be seized of
for and during her natural life.

2d. I give and devise after the death of my said
wife all the rents and profits derived from said
real estate during her lifetime she my said
wife is to keep up the improvements and pay
all taxes that may be assessed against said
real estate and that may in any way become
a lien against said real estate my said wife
is permitted to sell and use any timber growing
on said real estate to keep up improvements
thereon.

3d. I give and devise after the death of my said
wife share and share alike all my real estate to
my children named as follows, to wit: Berley Gene
Brodbeck, Vernon M. Brodbeck, Elabern J.
Brodbeck, Nellie Edith Brodbeck, Burness Mattie
etc. I make and appoint my said wife Annie
C. Brodbeck my executrix of this my last will
and testament.
