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Will of Zeckiah Brown 359

I Zeckiah Brown in the County
of Adams in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and sixty five
make and publish this my last will
and testament also I give and bequeath
unto my wife the sum of three hundred
dollars out of the personal property if so
much be. I also give unto her one third
of the rents and profits of the farm as long
as she shall live. I also give to Horace
Brown fifty dollars. I also give to Mary Jane
Brown one hundred dollars and the Bal-
ance of the property to be equally divided
between my Sons and Daughters
Horace H. Brown Emory Brown
Johnell Brown Charles W. Brown
Mary Jane Brown & Eleanor Brown
to be paid over when the Estate is set-
tled. And I hereby constitute and
appoint John Woy Executor of
this my last will and testament
