Will of Abraham Cuckler

In the name of Almighty God, I, the undersigned Abraham Cuckler being of sound mind and of full possession of all my mental & reasoning faculties but weak in body, and considering the uncertainty of human life and the possibility of soon being called from this earth as I shake about it a spirit and more my life seems to so arrange my worldly and temporal affairs to the best of my ability so as to be just and satisfactory to my family, I do hereby for & declare this to be my last will & testament and the provisions hereof of my own expressed wishes & intentions as in case of my death.

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Margaret Cuckler one third of all my property both real estate and personal I have and to hold the same as her portion or dower during her natural life. Provided however that it shall be her privilege and is in accordance with my wish that she shall get the full amount of the value of her third in the form I at present own in Wells Co. Ind as joint in the village of Viva Cruz,
I give and bequeath to Caroline Moore wife of Fred Moore and daughter of my wife the sum of eight hundred dollars.

I give and bequeath to my four children John, Mary, Sarah & Rebecca all the remainder of my property equal shares; Provided however that it has always been my intention to give my son John One thousand dollars more than the rest of my children and he has already received a part amount in personal property, it shall be calculated what the value of what he has received amounts to and then added thereto until it shall make up the sum of One thousand dollars, after that nothing this present clause shall be in force and a division made accordingly.

It is my will that the twenty acres of timber belong to me in Adams Co. but always considered as belonging to my farm in Wells Co. shall continue to be so considered and always belong to the farm in which I have bequeathed the one third to my wife.

It is my will & desire that my son John shall have the first right & privilege to buy my old household or any portion of it he desires in case the same at some
