I, Albert Buhler, of the City of Decatur, and State of Indiana, do hereby make, publish and declare this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following: First. I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as conveniently can be done.

Second. I authorize and empower, and it is my will that my executor hereinafter named, to sell and dispose of all of my personal property and real estate of which I do stand or possess at public or private sale, at the best price or prices that can be realized therefor, and as soon after my decease as can conveniently be done.

Third. It is my will and I hereby authorize and empower my executor to purchase and cause to be erected at my grave, a monument to cost not less than fifty dollars, nor more than sixty dollars.

Fourth. It is my will, and I hereby give and bequeath to my daughter, Grace D. Buhler, all the money derived from the sale of the property mentioned in Item second of this my last will and Testament, remaining in the hands of my said executor after paying all my just debts and funeral expenses and cost of administration and payment of the monument mentioned in item third of this my last will.

Fifth. I nominate, constitute and appoint Amos P. Beatty of Decatur, Indiana, executor of this my last will and Testament.

Sixth. I revoke all former wills and testamentary dispositions by me at any time heretofore made.

In witness whereof, I have herunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal in the City of Decatur, State of Indiana, this 23^d day of December, 1911, in the presence of Will Thomas and George Kingle, whom I have requested to become attesting witnesses hereto.
