(Immaculation)

In the name of God, Amen.

As it has pleased the Lord to visit me with  
sickness and being advanced in age and then-  
fore the hope of recovery very small, and, being at  
present of sound mind and having my full senses  
I therefore make my last will,

First: I bequeath to my grandsons & nearest  
Buhler one hundred <sup>no.</sup> fifty dollars (\$150<sup>00</sup>)

Second: I bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Buhler  
the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200<sup>00</sup>)

Third: As my son Albert Buhler has received  
his share some time ago already, he therefore  
has no claim to my remaining estate.

Fourth: I bequeath to my son Jacob Buhler  
the sum of five dollars \$5<sup>00</sup>

Fifth: I bequeath to my son John Buhler the sum  
of five dollars \$5<sup>00</sup>

Sixth: I bequeath to my daughter Mary & and  
her Buhler the sum of five dollars \$5<sup>00</sup>

Seventh: After my debts and funeral expenses  
have been paid, the remaining of my estate  
movable or not movable shall fall to  
my beloved wife Elizabeth Buhler,

Further it is my wish, if in any way possible  
that the above bequests be paid within sixty  
days.

It is also my wish that our pastor H. Witz shall  
act as executor.

Committing all my relations in the case of our  
heavenly Father's <sup>no.</sup> Doping that he will have mercy on my  
soul for Christ's sake, I sign my name this tenth day  
of August in the year of our Lord 1889
