 (3) I will, give and devise unto my beloved wife, Lily May Burkhead, for a single all of the real estate hereunto intended of which I may be seized.  
 (4) I will give and bequeath unto my said wife all the personal property of which I may be possessed, it being my own at my death, to wit: my said wife, all the property which I hereby constitute and appoint my said wife executor of this my last will and testament, empowering her to serve in that capacity without bond.
