## Will of Ernst Bunch

No. 227

I, Ernst Bunch of Deble Township in Adams County, the State of Indiana, do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills ever by me made or expressed. It is my will that after my death all my just debts and the expenses of my last sickness and funeral expenses be paid in full and of my estate.

1. Item Second. It is my will and I hereby direct that should my beloved wife Sophie Bunch out live me she shall have and hold for and during her life time all I am the owner of at my death, to have and to hold for and during her natural life time.

2. Item Third. After the death of myself and the death of my said wife, I give and bequeath to my son Wilhelm Bunch, the following described real estate in Adams County in the State of Indiana to wit: Sixty one and a half ( $61\frac{1}{2}$ ) acres to be taken off of the north side of the north east quarter of section ten (10) in township twenty eight (28) north range thirteen (13) east, and also the northwest fractional quarter of the north east quarter of section three (3) in said township twenty eight (28) north range thirteen (13) east, all in Adams County, Indiana, containing forty and fifty one ( $40\frac{1}{2}$ ) acres more or less and also all the stock and farming utensils and all the household goods that may be on said farms at my death, to be paid to my estate. Three thousand dollars (\$3000) to be paid in payments of two hundred (\$200) dollars per year should he, my son Wilhelm pay some of said payments either to me in my life time or to my wife in her life time he will hold receipts or receipts for such payments, which amount shall be deducted out of the amount above stated.

4. Item Fourth. My son Frederick I have given him all in a tract of land in Allen County, Indiana and he shall therefore have no more out of my estate unless all the above bequests herein have been fully complied with then if there is anything left over he shall have an equal share with the rest of my children.

5. Item Fifth. To my son Ernst H. Bunch, I give the sum of One thousand Dollars (\$1000) subject to an account in a book which I am keeping in which I note the amount I may pay him during my life time.

6. Item Six. To my son Martin Bunch I give the sum of one thousand (\$1000) Dollars subject to an account in a book which I am keeping in which I note the amount I may pay him during my life time.

7. Item Seven. To my son Christian Bunch, I give the sum of One thousand (\$1000) Dollars subject to an account in a book which I am keeping in which I note the amount I may pay him during my life time.

8. Item Eight. To my daughter, Louise Korubenberg, I give five hundred (\$500) Dollars subject to an account in a book which I am keeping, in which I note

the amount I may pay her in my life time.

9. Item Ninth. To my daughter, Wilhelmine, I give five hundred Dollars (\$500) subject to an account in a book which I am keeping in which I note the amount I may pay her in my life time.

10. Item Tenth. To my daughter Elizabeth I give five hundred Dollars (\$500) subject to an account in a book which I am keeping in which I note the amount I may pay her in my life time.

11. Item Eleven. The residue of my estate I will that it be equally divided among my said eight children herein above named, share and share alike. Witness my hand and seal this 27th day of February A.D. 1904
