 and memory, considering the uncertainty and
 continuance in life and desiring to make such
 disposition of my worldly estate as I deem best,
 do make, publish and declare this to be my
 last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and
 annulling any and all former wills or wills
 in whole or in part by me made.

Item First: I will and direct that all my
 just debts, and funeral expenses shall be paid
 by my executor, as soon as possible after my
 decease.

Item Second: I give, devise and bequeath, to
 my beloved wife, Sarah Eyster, all the residue
 of my property, both real and personal, that I
 now have or may have, at my death, to be hers
 absolutely forever.

Item Third: I do hereby nominate and appoint, my
 beloved wife, Sarah Eyster, executor of this
 my last Will and Testament, and authorizing and
 empowering her, to compromise, adjust, release
 and discharge, in such manner as she may deem
 proper, the debts and claims due me.

In testimony hereof, I have hereunto set my hand,
 this 27th day of May, A. D. 1905.

Orders On Hearing, Admission To Probate And Record.
 (Testimony Of Subscribing Witnesses In Court)
 Probate Court, Pleas County, Ohio.

In the Matter of the Will of George S. Egely, Deceased
 Do hereby certify that on the 21st day of December, 1910, an instrument of writing purporting to be the Last Will and Testament of George S. Egely, late of said Township, in the County of Allen, Ohio, was produced in open court and received for probate and was then filed, and after being shown to the satisfaction of the Court that the same is a true copy of the original and that the notice of the filing of said Will and of the application to admit the same to probate and record in the court, has been given to the widow and next of kin of the testator, residing in the State of Ohio, pursuant to an order of the Court. Thereupon on this 21st day of December came J. L. Baker and J. Warren Tolson the subscribing witnesses to said Will; who being duly sworn testified to the execution and attestation of said Will, which testimony was reduced to writing, by said witnesses, respectively subscribed, and filed with said Will. Whereupon the Court made the following instrument of writing in the Last Will and Testament of George S. Egely deceased; that the same was truly executed and attested; and that the said testator, at the time of making same, was of sound and making the same was of full age, of sound mind and memory, and not under any restraint. It is therefore, by the Court ordered, that the said Will be admitted to probate, and that the same, together with the testimony of the witnesses above named be entered of record in this Court. It is further ordered that the executor pay the costs herein taxed at \$ within days.
