In the name of God Amen I Solomon Capitaine of Morse Township, Adams County and State of Indiana of the age of sixty two years and being of sound mind and memory and understanding publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows. First, it is my wish and desire that after my death my wife Margarita Capitaine shall have the full right to all my property both personal and real all (fee simple) as long as she remains my Widow. Second, it is my wish and desire that after her my wife's death my son Fredrich shall have the sum of Ten Dollars. The balance of my property shall be divided Equal to my children John, Adeline, Malinda Lisa, Lucinda, Except Lucinda shall have the sum of Three Hundred dollar more than any of the other.

I Solomon Capitaine declare this to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I set my hand and subscribe my name this the 14th day of August A.D. 1869
