It is my will and I bequeath all the property, real, personal or mixed of which I may be seized to my children or their living issue, share and share alike, that is to say my will that Susan Carpenter, Glenna Carpenter, (formerly Martha Jane Carpenter) and the heirs of Glenna Carpenter (formerly Anna Carpenter) on the heirs surviving of any of the above at my death, shall each receive the one eighth part of all my estate.
