Nov. 1030 Will of Matthias Bloss

I Matthias Bloss of Decatur in the County
of Adams in the State of Indiana do make
and publish this my last my last will and
testament, hereby revoking and making
~~void~~ void all former wills by me at any time
heretofore made. First, I direct my body bedeviled
in terror, and as to such worldly estate as it
has pleased God to entrust me with, I dispose
of the same in the following manner,
Nowit, I direct, that all ^{my} just debts and funeral
expenses be paid as soon after my decease
as possible out of the first first money that
shall come to the hands of my Executor, from
any portion of my Estate. Real or personal.
I also direct that the whole of my personal prop-
erty and the whole of my Real Estate shall be
and remain the absolute property of my
beloved father if he shall be living at the
time of my decease. And I further declare and
direct that the whole of my personal
property and real Estate they bequeath-
ed to John Bloss. My said father, shall
be and remain his, if I should not sur-
vive my present sickness. But if I should
Recover my health again then the said
personal property and Real Estate
shall be and remain my own.
As though this will had never been
executed And I hereby make and
ordain my father John Bloss my
Executor of this my last will and testament.

testator Matthias Gless and from such
acquaintance believe him to have been of
sound mind and memory and under
no coercion or restraint, And that he
was of full age to devise his property

Gless each subscribed their names to the
