In the name of the Democratic District of all
 of Joseph M. Donagle of Adams County State of
 Indiana do hereby publish this my last
 will and testament hereby revoking all former
 wills by me made.

Item 1. It is my will that my executors here-
 after named shall pay all my just debts and
 funeral expenses as soon after my death
 as is possible for to do.

Item 2. I give devise and bequeath to my
 beloved wife Elizabeth M. Donagle all my property
 her real and personal that I may own at the
 time of my death, to have and to use during
 her natural life; provided however if it
 becomes necessary for the support and
 maintenance of my said wife or for the
 payment of my just debts, that my executors
 hereafter named, shall have power to sell
 any or all real estate owned by me at
 the time of my death, and to make a good and
 sufficient deed therefor.

Item 3. It is my further will, that whatever
 of my estate shall be left remaining after the
 death of my beloved wife Elizabeth M. Donagle
 be divided equally each sharing alike to
 be my beloved daughters my grand
 daughter, viz; Aggie Mackup, of the City of
 Delphi in the State of Ohio, Margaret J. Downie
 of the City of Decatur State of Indiana and
 my grand daughter Mrs Anna Letz. My
 daughter Mrs Aggie Mackup is to be charged
 with the sum of two hundred dollars
 heretofore advanced to her. My daughter
 daughter Mrs Margaret J. Downie is to be charged
 with the sum of eight hundred dollars
 heretofore advanced to her. My grand
 daughter Mrs Anna Letz is to be charged
 with the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars
 heretofore advanced to her. It is my will that

each of the above named Legatee shall receive
 an equal share of my estate
 Item 4. I hereby appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth
 M. Donagle the executrix of this my last will and
 testament, and it is my will that she shall not be
