Translation Will of Frederick C. Nahrwald

In the Name of God Amen,

I, Frederick C. Nahrwald of the Township of Frede, County of Adams and State of Indiana seventy years of age, being of sound mind and memory, in consideration of the uncertainty of this fragile and perishable life make, command, publish and declare this as my last will and Testament To-Wit:

1st To my son, Ernst Christian Nahrwald and his heirs all my property, personal and estate, excepting that my youngest daughter shall be heir of all articles or household goods found in the room I inhabit.

2nd My son Ernst Christian Nahrwald, shall pay to each of my other children, viz: Wilhelm Nahrwald, Minna Nahrwald, Sophia Nahrwald, Luise Nahrwald, Maria Nahrwald and Lebus Nahrwald, Fifty dollars (\$50⁰⁰) in the following manner. My son Wilhelm Nahrwald shall have his inheritance one year after my death.

The second child, Minna Nahrwald, two years after my death, and so on the following children according to ages, always one year later, so that the youngest child, Lebus, will get her inheritance in the seventh year after my death.

3^d Maria Nahrwald has already received Fifteen (\$15) Dollars of her inheritance. Sophia Nahrwald has received Twenty (\$20) Dollars.

4th Should there after my death, be any money on hand, the funeral expenses shall be paid out of it, and what is left shall be equally divided among my children.
