State of Indiana to wit the 1/4th part of the South East quarter of Section 36 North of Range 14 East of Township 13 North of Range 14 East of Adams County containing forty acres east in the division of lands by salient Fort Wayne Indiana containing property to I also give all my personal property to my wife that she has the right to convey and sell property as she see my hand and seal in witness whereof I set my hand and seal the second day of April 1889
