Last Will and Testament of Sarah Sprang.

no. 708. I, Sarah Sprang, of Allen County in the State of Indiana, do make and publish this my last will and Testament hereby revoking any and all wills by me heretofore made.

Item 1. It is my will and I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be first paid out of any estate of which I may die seized.

Item 2. I give devise and bequeath to my beloved children, George S. Sprang, Sarah A. Kuhn, Daniel Sprang, Simon P. Sprang, To the children of my beloved son Philip Sprang deceased, To the children of my beloved Daughter, Magdalen Hyde deceased, and to Frederick Hyde all the property both real and personal of which I may die seized to be shared by them as follows: in seven equal shares, to George S. Sprang one share, to Sarah A. Kuhn one share, to Simon P. Sprang one share, to Daniel Sprang one share, to the children of Philip Sprang one share, to the children of Magdalen Hyde one share, to Frederick Hyde one share. To my son Godfrey Sprang I bequeath nothing for the reason that he has already disposed of his interest in my estate to Frederick Hyde, and I therefore make the bequest of his interest to the said Frederick Hyde, to my son Jacob Sprang I bequeath nothing for the reason that he has already received his share from me as an advancement for which he has executed a written release and receipt.

Item 4. I hereby constitute and appoint my son Daniel Sprang as executor of this my last will and testament.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 8th day of February A.D. 1845.
