
I, Elias N. Pyrell, of the city of Decatur, in the county of Adams in the state of Indiana, being of sound mind, memory and understanding, do make public and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all wills by me at any time heretofore made, to wit:

Item First. It is my will and I hereby direct that all my just debts, including funeral expenses and expenses of my last sickness be paid as soon after my death as the same reasonably can.

Item Second. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife all the real estate which I may own at the time of my death to be hers in fee simple.

Item Third. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife all the personal property which I may have and own at the time of my death, to be hers absolutely and to include all my money, book accounts, notes and my interest in the blacksmith shop and owing to the firm of E. N. Pyrell and Company that my estate be settled without any me taking out letters of Administration of the same can be so done.


