In the Name of the Reverent Father of all.

I, the said Anna Vogeli, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, considering the uncertainty of continuance in life, and desiring to make such disposition of my worldly estate as I deem best, do make, publish and declare, this to be my last will and testament; hereby revoking and annulling any and all former will or wills whatsoever by me made.

First: I desire all my just debts and funeral expenses to be paid, as soon as possible after my decease.

Second: I give and bequeath all my clothes and Bedclothe to my two sisters Marie and Elisabeth to be equally divided among them or their heirs.

Third: It is my will and testament that all the furniture, and household goods to me belonging shall be equally divided between my two sisters and brother Marie, Elisabeth and Samuel or their heirs.

Fourth: - I give and bequeath the residue of alls my personal and real property to the First Mennonite Church of Berne Adams County, Indiana

In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 17th day of March, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine
