Last Will of Testament of Catharine Weffley.

In the Name of the Benevolent Father of All:
I, the undersigned Catharine Weffley, residing
in Root Township, Adams County, Indiana, being
of sound mind and disposing memory, but realizing
the uncertainty of life, do make public and
declare the following to be my last will and testa-
ment, hereby revoking any and all wills by me
heretofore made, to-wit:

Item First.

It is my will, and I hereby will, devise and
bequeath to my beloved son, Andrew S. Weffley, and
all property that I may own at my decease, be the
same, real estate, personal property, money, or any
other kind of property I may own at the time of
my decease. The said property so bequeathed to my
said son to be his absolutely and in fee simple, my
subject however to my just debts and funeral expenses,
which, to my said son shall pay.
