my last will and testament, revoking all former wills, previously made by me:

1. My son Lewis Westfeldt from my first marriage, now deceased received his due bequest nothing to him or his heirs.
2. To my son Henry Westfeldt I give and bequeath nine hundred therefore I now bequeath nothing to him or his heirs.
3. To my son Frederick Westfeldt I give and bequeath nine hundred dollars (\$900.00) out of the one thousand and one hundred dollars (\$1000.00) bequeathed by me to him; and the remaining two hundred dollars (\$200.00) and bequeath to my sons Frederick Westfeldt and William Westfeldt in equal parts.
4. To my son Frederick Westfeldt I give and bequeath of my remaining property nine hundred dollars (\$900.00) and also nine hundred dollars (\$900.00) to my son William Westfeldt.
5. I appoint Frederick Westfeldt executor of this will.
