SERVICES HELD TODAY FOR ELAM SPRUNGER, 58

Funeral services were held this afternoon in Van Nuys, Calif., for Elam Sprunger, 58, who died in Cody, Wyo., Wednesday enroute to Fort Wayne from Van Nuys, where he resided.

Mr. Sprunger, who formerly owned and resided at the Bass estate, was a prominent chicken hatchery owner while residing here, and pioneered in the study of poultry maturation and growth. In 1934 he went to the Pacific Coast to confer with Japanese poultry experts, and moved to the coast in 1945 to continue his study of poultry.

His wife, Alma, was with him at the time of his death.
