Jan. 22 - Mrs. Sarah Campbell dies at Geneva; Mrs. Harl Smith files suit for divorce; Death takes Chris Lobsiger.

Jan. 25 - Mrs. Edwin Heller dies.

Feb. 1 - Katherine Lehman Bixler dies at Kidron.

Feb. 12 - Mrs. Chris Gilliom dies.

Feb. 15 - Mrs. Albert Sprunger dies in Ohio.

Feb. 19 - J. P. Nussbaum dies; Mrs. Milton Gilliom dies at Ft. Wayne; Mrs. Mary Ashbaucher dies at Decatur.

March 5 - Death takes W. T. Tinkham; Jeff Klopfenstein dies at Fort Wayne; Florine Augsburg is bride of Millard Sprunger.

March 8 - Mrs. Peter F. Graber dies.

(date missing) - Ruth Neuenschwander is bride of Harvey Lehman.

March 15 - Nathan Cole of Wabash township found dead in barn; Earl William Haggard, 12, dies at Pleasant Mills from ruptured appendix.

March 19 - Charles Makley sentenced to electric chair at Lima, Ohio; Clorinda Lehman bride of Ronald Yoder; Vera Huser, Leo Hanni wed; Anna Luginbill bride of Ira Sprunger; Richard Hall dies at Aurora, Ill.; Elmer Hirschy weds Esther Shelby.

March 22 - Reuben Amstutz of Pittsburg, who has many relatives here, fatally burned in explosion in that city; Peter Gilliom found dead in bed.

March 26 - Makley and Pierpont sentenced to die July 13 in electric chair at Columbus.

March 29 - Miss Sarah Augsburgers dies at home on East Main street; Mrs. Frank Martin, daughter of Mrs. Dan Zuercher dies at Cedarville, north of Fort Wayne.

April 2 - Miss Margaret Rawley is bride of Willard Baumgartner; Norman Sprunger weds Miss Harriet Luginbill; Herman Burke weds Miss Virginia Callihan.

April 5 - Mrs. J. A. Sprunger dies here; Ora Werling dies at Newcastle; Henry Gerber weds Ada Hyerly; Pearl Whitehurst sues Clarence Whitehurst for divorce; Flossie Jean Habegger, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Enoch Habegger, dies; lifeless body of infant found in can in ditch near Bryant.

April 12 - Mrs. Fred Maurer dies; Harry Lawson weds Anna Denney; Thomas Noah Augsburgers, infant son of Mr. and Mrs. Palmer Augsburgers dies.

April 16 - Clarence Smitley of Jefferson township killed when grindstone flies to pieces, one piece hitting him; Velma Stucky weds Dale Stout; Mrs. Ernest Franz dies; Neola Habegger, Carl Luginbill wed; Donald Wayne Brewster dies.

April 23 - Elfrieda Habegger is bride of Ellison Neuenschwander; John Cook dies at infirmary; Paul Yoder weds Miss Florence Myers.

April 26 - William Gordon killed by freight train at Liberty Center; Mr. and Mrs. N. H. McClain celebrate Golden Wedding; Melvin Diehl dies in Kirkland township; Shirley Mae Zuercher, infant daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Elmer Zuercher dies.

April 30 - Mayor John Kelly dies at Bluffton.

May 3 - Luetta Huser weds Tod Faller; Gorm?? Reynolds dies at Vera Cruz.
