Milo Sales Dies at Home in Hartford Township Friday

Funeral services for Milo Sales, aged 60, who died at 2:10 o'clock Friday afternoon at his home in Hartford township, near Linn Grove, were held Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Linn Grove Evangelical church of which he was a member. Burial was made in Greenwood cemetery.

Mr. Sales suffered a stroke Friday a week ago and his condition had been serious since then. He was a well known farmer and was known throughout the community.

The deceased was a son of Simon and Rachel Briggs, and was born in Ohio, May 20, 1872. He spent his entire life at farming. He was married to Cora Meshberger, the couple having their wedding anniversary on July 4th.
