MOSES STUCKY DIES AT WOODBURN Final Rites For Native of This Community Are Sunday

Moses Stucky, 78, a native of French township, died at his home in Woodburn at 4:30 a.m. today of obstruction of the bowels. He lived in this community until about a year after his marriage to Mary Gerig, 54 or 55 years ago.

The decedent was born May 7, 1862, the son of Nicholas and Verena Schmucker Stucky.

Mr. and Mrs. Stucky celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary March 1, 1935. Mrs. Stucky survives.

Surviving are two children, Simon of Woodburn and Mrs. Edna King of Woodburn. One brother, Peter, of this place, and two sisters, Mrs. C. N. Stucky and Miss Christina survive. Three brothers, Nicholas, Daniel and Samuel, and two sisters, Barbara and Katherine, preceded as did three in infancy.

Funeral services will be held at Woodburn Sunday at 2 p.m.
