Mrs. Rose M. Clark, 67, prominent local lady and member of a pioneer Decatur family, died shortly after 2 o'clock this afternoon at the Adams county memorial hospital. Death was attributed to complications. She had been ill only three weeks. At that time she submitted to an operation at the hospital. Her condition became gradually worse, however, until her death.
