Death Takes Louis Conrad

Father of Former Pastor of Local Church Dies at Hospital

Louis Conrad, 74, Kirkland township farmer, died Wednesday morning at 2:00 at the Adams county memorial hospital of carcinoma.

Mr. Conrad was the father of late Rev. J.L. Conrad, former pastor of the Cross Reformed church here, who died on March 28, 1936.

The deceased was a native of Germany, born May 16, 1864. He was first married to Louise Scherry who preceded him in death. Two children by this union are deceased.

He was later married to Sophia Kruetzmann, who survives. He came to this country when 18 years old. He was a member of the Salem Reformed church.

Surviving besides the widow are the following children: Mrs. Walter Reppert, Walter Conrad and Mrs. Elmer Peters, all of Magley. All brothers and sisters are deceased.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 1:30 at the home three miles south of Magley and 2:00 at the church. Burial will be in the church cemetery. Rev. David Grether will officiate.
