Mrs. Charles Pusey is Dead

Sister of Local Man Dies Monday; Funeral this afternoon

Mrs. Mary Liechty Pusey, 67, wife of Charles E. Pusey, well-known Hartford Township farmer, died of a heart attack at about 2:30 o'clock Monday afternoon at her home, 7 miles southwest of Berne. She had been ill since Sunday.

The deceased was born January 11, 1872, in Hartford Township, the daughter of Peter J. and Maryann Moser Liechty. She was a lifelong resident of this county and was married to Charles E. Pusey on February 12, 1900.

Funeral services were conducted at the home at 1:30 this afternoon and at 2 o'clock at the Union Chapel M.E. Church where she was a faithful member. The Rev. Bender officiated and interment was in the Alberson Cemetery south of Linn Grove.
