Former Berne Resident Dies

Mrs. Ralph Schindler Dies Saturday Night at Wabash Hospital

Mrs. Ralph Schindler, 33, of North Manchester, died at 5:30 pm Saturday at the Wabash Hospital following an emergency operation performed Saturday morning. She had been ill several days, suffering from gall stones.

The deceased was born in Berne, October 6, 1906, a daughter of Carl and Bertha Liechty Lehman. She was married to Ralph Schindler and lived in Berne until two years ago when Mr. Schindler accepted a position in a furniture factory in North Manchester.

She is survived by her husband and three sons, (torn name), Keith and Robert, the parents Mr. and Mrs. Carl Lehman of Berne and the following brothers and sisters: Ellis and Mark Lehman and Mrs. Robert Harker, all of Berne, Arthur of North Manchester and Paul of Peru.

Funeral services were held at the home in North Manchester this afternoon at 2:30 o'clock after which the body was brought to the Lehman home in Berne.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday at 2 pm in the Mennonite Church in Berne, with burial in the MRE Cemetery.
