EXPLAIN RULE OF DEFERMENT

Draft Board Explains Ruling on Status Of Married Men

Members of the Adams county draft board today issued a statement in explanation of the ruling regarding the deferment of married men for selective service training.

The board called attention to the fact that a bulletin received from national headquarters, signed by President Roosevelt, and posted on the bulletin board of the local office, has been used as a guide in considering the cases of married men.

This ruling requires that the board give the same consideration to a registrant, who was married after October 16, 1940 - the registration date - as those who were married prior.

Thus, they pointed out a man who was married only recently must be, under the ruling, given the same consideration for a class 3-A deferment.

11 IN 4-E

Only 11 registrants are still in class 4-E, those who object to both combatant and non-combatant training, a survey of draft board records revealed today.

At one time at least two dozen men were in that class. Since that time many have secured reclassifications. Some have proven dependency and been placed in class 3-A, while others have removed their objections to non combatant training and asked for 1-A, 0 classification.

To date, no call for the 4-E men has been received by the local board. These men are to be placed in camps maintained by churches and private organization and will be required to pay \$35 per month.

UPHOLD DRAFT BOARD RULINGS

Appeals Board Upholds Classifications by County Board

Board of appeals No. 4, at Fort Wayne, has upheld the decision of the Adams county draft board in each of the seven cases submitted to it by county registrants who appealed the classifications as given them here, it was shown today in a survey of draft board records.

Seven youths appealed from classifications given them by the local board, but all seven appeals were denied and their classification unchanged. One appeal is still pending.

The appeals for reclassification denied follow:

Alfred Arthur Aeschliman, No. 11 of Decatur, route 4, was place in 1-B, O and asked 3-A.

Roman Joseph Brite, 234, Decatur, route two, was placed in class 1-A, and asked 3-A.

Robert Lee Meshberger, 263, Berne, route one, was placed in class 1-A and asked 2-A.

Glen Gerald Woodruff, 504, now of LaPorte, was placed in class 1-A and asked 2-A or 3-A.

Max Duane Grandlienard, 687, Bluffton, route three, was placed in class 1-A and asked 2-A.

Ralph Raymond Mankey, 703, Craigville, route one, was placed in class 1-A and asked 2-A.

Loren Clinton Gottschalk, 719, Geneva, route one, was placed in class 1-A and asked 2-A. The appeal still pending before the district appeal board:

Harvey Laverne Steffen, 897, Decatur, route four, was placed in class 4-E and asked 3-A. It is customary for 4-E cases appealed to be given to the FBI for investigation, state draft board officials have asserted.

Registrants who are not satisfied with their classifications have five days to make an appointment with the local draft board to seek a new classification. At the time of the appointment, the registrant is to submit new evidence and affidavits substantiating his contentions. After reviewing the case, the board notifies the registrant. If still not satisfied, the registrant has five days in which to ask for an

board of appeals. The district board reports to the local board, which in turn notifies the registrant of the decision. If he is not yet satisfied, he has five days to make an appeal to the president of the United States.

MUST QUALIFY

Before he can appeal to the president, however, he must be qualified in certain respects. Most

important of these is the one which says that his appeal can be made on grounds of dependency only. He must have been placed in class 1-A or 4, and one or more members of the appeal board

must have cast a dissenting vote in his classification. A member of the local board, an appeal agent or the governor of the state, must also sign a statement, recommending the change in classification. It was pointed out that in the case of one youth listed above, Robert Lee Meshberger, notice of his intentions to appeal to the president had been served on the local board. Since he could not appeal on the grounds of dependency, nor were their any dissenting votes cast in his classification, the right to appeal had to be denied, it was stated.
