ARMY NURSE TO GO TO HAWAII

Marcella Brandyberry To Serve In Hawaii For Two Years

Lieut. Marcella "Sally" Brandyberry, formerly of this city, will sail from San Francisco on October 10 for Hawaii, where she will serve in the medical reserve corps.

Miss Brandyberry was one of six young nurses to be dispatched yesterday from Fort Knox, Kentucky, to San Francisco.

These young women are the first to be sent to the corps in Hawaii. They will serve there for a period of two years before returning to the United States.

Miss Brandyberry is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Brandyberry, of Tenth street. She enlisted in the medical reserve corps of the army last January.

She was recently injured in an army truck accident but is reported to be completely recovered.
