(PHOTO) A farewell service for Rev. and Mrs. Spurgeon Hendrix and son Arlan Ray will be held Sunday, August 17, at 7:30 p.m. CST at the Mount Hope church of the Nazarene, located northeast of Berne, of which the Rev. Spurgeon Hendrix is pastor. Mrs. Hendrix is also a licensed preacher.

The popular young couple who made hundreds of friends in Berne and its environs will sail on Friday, August 29, from New York City to Buenos Aires, Argentina, where they will serve as missionaries.

Another farewell service will be held Sunday at the local church of which Rev. E. B. Hartley is pastor, at 2:00 p.m. DST. The Rev. Hendrix served the Mt. Hope charge for the past three years.

Next week they will attend the District Assembly of the Nazarene church, to be held at Marion.

Rev. and Mrs. Hendrix and son were recently feted at a farewell service in a Fort Wayne Nazarene church at which the Rev. James Montgomery, district superintendent, was the principal speaker. Dr. Montgomery will attend the farewell services here and at Mt. Hope Sunday and deliver messages.

The Mt. Hope church of the Nazarene, organized in 1937, has grown along every line and has made commendable records during that time and through Rev. and Mrs. Hendrix. A rededication program following an extensive remodeling program was held Sunday, May 4, of this year.
