Salome Schug and Rev. Ernest Kuhnle Wed Here Local School Teacher Wed in Church Ceremony Last Evening

In an unusual all-white wedding, Miss Salome Schug, local school teacher and Rev. Ernest Kuhnle of Detroit, were married at the Cross Evangelical and Reformed Church last evening at 8:00 o'clock. The congregation of the Berne Missionary Church of which the bride is a member and many other friends witnessed the ceremony. The wedding took place at the Reformed Church because the Missionary Church is in process of renovation.

The son of the bridegroom, Rev. William Kuhnle of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, officiated with an impressive single ring ceremony, read from memory. Immediately at the close of the service he announced that the son of the groom had given them in marriage and that the couple would be glad to receive the congratulations of their friends.

Mrs. Kuhnle, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Schug, both deceased, has been teaching in the Berne Schools for twenty years and is a member of the Berne Alumni Association. She taught at the Fort Wayne Bible Institute for five years from which institution she graduated. She holds a B.S. degree from Wheaton College and has traveled widely, including trips to the Holy Land, to Alaska, and a number of times to both coasts. Recently she resigned her position as English instructor in the local high school. She taught in the grade schools and Junior High before becoming a member of the high school faculty.

Rev. Kuhnle is a graduate of the Fort Wayne Bible Institute and for many years served the various churches of the Missionary Church, including a pastorate at the Pandora, Ohio Missionary Church. At the present, he is pastor of the Baldwin Avenue Church in Detroit Michigan.
