Mrs. Frank Neadstine Dies This Morning

Decatur Lady Dies Suddenly Today

Mrs. Louisa Neadstine, 72, wife of Frank Neadstine, died this morning at 10:30 o'clock at her home, 808 North Second Street. Death was attributed to a cerebral hemorrhage and came suddenly, although she had been ailing since February 25.

She was born in Root Township December 22, 1861, the daughter of Henry and Emma Custer-Luttman. She had resided in Decatur for the past 21 years, moving here from Blue Creek Township. She was a member of the Zion Lutheran Church.

January 10, 1886, she was married to Frank Neadstine, who survives. Surviving also are four children: John Neadstine, William Neadstine and Mrs. Jacob Dolch, all of Blue Creek Township, and Mrs. Lorena Hook of Monroe; 11 grandchildren; four brothers, Ed Luttman of Sturgis, Michigan; William and Martin of Fort Wayne and Henry of Adams County. Two children are deceased.

Funeral services will be held Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Zion Lutheran Church, with Rev. Paul W. Schultz officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur Cemetery.
