Noah Johnson Dies Today at Hospital

Noah Johnson, 78, farmer residing two and one half miles west of Monroe, died at the Adams County Memorial Hospital this morning at 9 o'clock of complications, developing from influenza and pneumonia. He has been in poor health for the last year and seriously ill since last Friday.

His brother, Levi Johnson, died Monday evening at 6:20 o'clock of a cerebral hemorrhage.

The two lived together on Noah John's farm.

Double funeral services will be held for the two brothers at the Monroe Methodist Church, Friday at 1:30 o'clock with Rev. O. Kegeneke, pastor of the church, officiating. Burial will be in the Ray Cemetery at Monroe. Previously, services had been announced for Thursday, but will be delayed a day.

Neither of the brothers had ever been married. They are survived by one sister, Mrs. Matilda McGown of Miamisburg, Ohio and a number of nieces and nephews, including Frank Ulrick and Frank Johnson of Decatur, and Mrs. Hahnert, of Monroe. Three brothers and three sisters are deceased.
