Former Auditor of County is Paroled

Victor H. Eicher, 42, Adams county auditor, has been granted a parole from the Indiana state prison at Michigan City by Governor Henry Schricker, upon recommendation of the state clemency commission.

A copy of the governor's parole was received this morning in the Adams county clerk's office. It sets out that he is to be paroled "when suitable arrangements are made for his release, with the understanding that he is to make regular reports until the expiration of his maximum term." Eicher was sentenced on November 13, 1942 by Judge J. Fred Fruchte in the Adams circuit court to serve a 2-21 year term for embezzling public funds.

He had previously entered a plea of guilty to embezzling \$7,575.89 during his term in the office.
