SECOND OF HERMAN COOK TWINS DIES

Jo? Lynn, 2 1/2 Month's Old, Dies In Hospital - Funeral Saturday P.M.

Jo? Lynn, two-and-a-half month's old son of Mr. and Mrs. Herman Cook, died Thursday evening at 7:05 o'clock at the Lutheran Hospital where the infant was admitted a week ago tonight at 11:30 o'clock. The child was the surviving member of a pair of twins, a girl in the pair, Janet Lou, having died when two days old.

Toxic nephrosis is given as the cause of death, the same ailment that caused the sister to die earlier. The boy had made good progress and was gaining nicely when suddenly he became critically ill.

The babies were born on May 6, the children of Herman and Luetta Sprunger-Cook, who survive as does a sister, Bonnie Joy.

The body was returned to their apartment at 417 ?ark street this noon. Funeral services will be held at the Mennonite church Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock preceded by a short ?? service. Burial will be in the M.R.E. cemetery, with Rev. C. H. Suckau officiating at the service tomorrow afternoon.
