Fred E. Swaim was born Septemebr 16, 1868, the son of William F. Swaim and Mary (Thompson) Swaim.

The first thirteen years of his life was spent on a farm, two and one half miles East of Warrn., attending school at the 'ZENT' school house school house. During the year 1881, his father acquired and interest in a Planing Mill and lumber yeard in Warren, and the family acquired residence in thw town of Warren. The son, an only child attended the local school and graduated from High School, April 1, 1886, in a class of four, being the first Graduating class in the county outside the County seat, Huntington.

The following winter he engaged in teaching, the first year being at school No. 2 in Polk township. A few years spent in teaching, the 1 the last one being at School No. 2 in Salamonie township.

At the November election in the year 1894, his father was elected County auditor, and the following year assumed the office, having selected his son to act as his deputy. This service lasted until Novmber 1st 1899, following which he took service with the Citizens State Bank in Huntington.

On the 28 day September 1889, he was married to Amelia M. Irwin, daughter of Matthew Irwin. To this union, one daughter was born, Edith M., who in later years married Charles L. Elvin. Two children were born to this union, Dorothy R. and Robert W., the daughter Dorothy, now married to Henry dugan of Louisville, Kentucky, and the Son Robert married Wilma Obenour. A daughter was born to this union, Pamela Sue Elvin. This marriage ended in divorce, the custody of the daughter being granted the father, after a number of court sessions. Robert has since married Helen Holmes, a widow.

The first wife of this subject died when the daughter was thirteen and the daughter and her father made their home with the Grand-parents. Umne 2 1990, the father married Lota M. Baker and a few weeks later the daughter married as above noted.

The ancestral history of this subject extends back many years. The Swaim family trace the history of the family to the year 1638 when the Swedes and Fins settled New Jersey and Deleware.
