Our parents and grandparents (Charles and Bessie) ancestors came to America from Germany. The history of German emmigrants is interesting and full of history. Most Germans came to America seeking a better standard of life and fleeing persecutions.

Have you ever thought about your name? What does your name mean? In Taylors book the following is found about the Kneller name.

"The surname Kneller is a comparatively rare name, and appears to be occupational in origion. Our research indicates that it can be associated with the Germans and English, meaning 'one who was a bell ringer' ". There are also several variations of the Kneller name, i.e., Knellers, Knelle, Knell and Kniller.

While we are defining names, aldow me to mention Bessies family name, Sievers, Siever (ger) descendant of Sigiwart(victory, worthy).

There is also a Kneller Coat of Arms which is described in detail on the preceeding page.

Following is a synppsis of the family, more details are located in the following family charts and newsletter.

1. Charles was born, raided and died in Whitley County, Indiana. Charles married Bessie Sievers in August 1905 and settled in the community of Peabody, Washington township, Whitley County, Indiana. It was here they raised twelve children: 7 sons and 5 daughters: Carl, Charles, Harold, Lloyd, Floyd, Ralph, Walter, Beatrice, Georgia, Margaret, Marie, and Rosella.

Charles supported his family by farming, threshing, and operating a saw mill, as well as raising stock.

Charles and Bessie were members of St.John Lutheran Church.

2. George Kneller was the father of Charles. George was born in Green Township, Noble County, Indiana in the year of 1856. When George was 11 years old, his family settled in Washington Township, Whitlet County, Indiana. In 1881 George married Rebecca Auer, the daughter of Jphn Michael Auer and Mary Smith. Michael was a native of Wurtemberg, Germany and Mary a native of Starke Co., Ohio. The children of George and Rebecca were: Charles F., John M., Daniel, Joseph H., Sherman L., and Catherine Hardner Lantz. 3. Georges father was Gottlieb and he emmigrated from Germany in 1849 to Columbiana Co., Ohio. It was there he met and married Catherine Lederer (Ledner, Lethers) in 1851. Catherine was also a native of Germany. Gottlieb moved his wife to Noble Co., Indiana in 1852 and remained there until 1864. At that time the family moved to Columbia Twp, Whitley Co., Indiana staying there two years. In 1866 or 1867, Gottlieb purchased a farm of 127 acres in Sectiom 1 in Washington Twp.

Gottlieb and Catherine had 10 Children: Fred, John, Catherine, George, Daniel, Joseph, Amandia, Henry, Jennie, Sarah and Rachael Karns.

The following was taken from the book, "history of Whitley County." by Kolar and Marning.

"Among the German emigrants contributed to this country during the early years of the 19th century was a poor but industrious young man by the name of Gottlieb Kneller. He was fairly well educated before leaving the fatherland and entered upon his career in the new world with the persistent patience and uncoquerable ambition characteristic of his race. In due time, he found himself "up against" the serious proposition of making a living in a new country. He worked as a laborer in Ohio for a few years but hearing much of the new State of Indiana, he concluded to try his fortune there and joined the rush to the northeast, when all that Section was still wrapped in primeval wilderness. He settled in Noble County, where he farmed for some years. Afterward he moved over into neighboring county of Whitley . He purchased o80 acres from Fred Dreyer and another piece of 47 acres, all in Washington Twp, which he spent the rest of his days in improving and farming, until his death in 1882, He married Catherine Lethers, also a native of Germany and had 11 children."

4. Little is known of Gottliegs family. His parents were Leonard and Charlotte and there were at least two sons, Gottlieb and George.

Leonard died in 1831. Charlotte remarried in 1831 to one William Giles who died in 1843. Charlotte died in 1855. 1. Bessie was christened Bessie Frederica Margarata Wilhelmina Sievers!! Bessie was a housewife and cut a lot of hair for extra cash.

2. Bessies parents were Henry Sievers and Minerva Bordner. Henry was born in Whitley County, three and one half miles south of Columbia City and spent practically all of his life within the county. Henrys education was a German education in a parochial school and learned English in the districts schools although he attended only seven months.

Henry was raised on a farm so he decided to make agriculture his vocation and was very successful. Henry stayed on his fathers farm until he was 24 years old, then receiving a part of his mothers inheritance and later bought the other heirs shares. Henry farmed eighty acres with sixty-five under cultivation. Henry made many improvements by adding a home, barn, outbuildings, fenced the property and added drainage. Henry also became a trustee in Columbia Township.

In the year 1885, Henry married Minerva Bordner, also of Whitley County. Minervas parents were William Bordner, a native of Pennsylvania and Sarah Snyder, a native of Ohio.

Henry and Minerva had seven children listed in the "History of Whitley County". Bessie wife of Charles Kneller, farmer and stock-raiser; Dora V. graduate of the public schools and still at home; William H. worked for his father; Mary; Charles W,; Sarah and Alice R.

The Sievers family were members of the Lutheran Church and for eight years Henry was a trustee. For 14 years Henry sold for Farmer's Mutual Fire Insurance Company which he did a large and luctative business in and around Whitley County. After 14 years Henry resigned to accept the office of township trustee being elected in 1904. Henry was also a party leader for the Democratic party.

Under Henrys trusteeship he had eight schools, transfered about 100 pupils to the Columbia City schools, 18 of which were in high school. He erected one new school building.

The above information was gathered from "Whitley County History" pages 649-50.

3. William Sievers, Henrys father, came to America from Germany when he was about 14 years old. His family settled in Whitley County, William helped in clearing land for a farm which William later owned. Although William had a good education in Germany, he knew nothing about the English language, but by mixing with his friends and neighbors, he learned to converse quite fluently.

After William began farming for himself he became so successful and by purchasing land at various times, soon owned 233 acres. In time William divided his property among his children, keeping only enough for his home and a comfortable living.

William was married three times, his first wife dying in 1869, was the mother of four children. Nancy (Mrs William H. Smith) was a farmer and stoch-raiser in Whitley County; Henry; William Jr. were farmers and did threshing; and August was a farmer. In the Columbia City News, Mrs Augusta Keiser was listed as a child born of Williams second marriage

(Henry Lewis Sievers, a brother of William Sr., was born in Germany Apr 26, 1825, died Aug 16, 1907 at age 82 years 4 months 25 days. 10 children survived: Mrs. Fred Keyser, Herman, Mrs, Ermest Saurman, Mrs, Henry Schroeder, Mrs. Fred Bloom, Frank, Fred, Mrs. Dan Hunziker and August).
