NEW CORYDON WOMAN DEAD

Stroke Fatal to Mrs. Rose M. Buckingham, Lifelong Resident of County

Mrs. Rose Myrtle Buckingham, 60, died at her home in New Corydon at 2:10 o'clock yesterday afternoon from the effects of a stroke suffered a week ago.

Mrs. Buckingham was born in Jay county January 7, 1882, daughter of William and Clara (Wintrow) Vettters. She was married 40 years ago to Harry Buckingham. They were the parents of six children of whom four survive: Mrs. Madge Stoltz of Mercer county, O.; Mrs. Clara Walter of Wabash township, Mrs. Gretchen Snyder of New Corydon and Doris Buckingham, at home.

She also leaves a sister, Mrs. Mollie Butcher of Geneva and a half-sister, Mrs. Della Reitenour of New Castle. A brother and a sister are deceased.

The body will be taken from the Metzner funeral home at Bryant to the late residence this afternoon to remain until one hour before the funeral which will be held at the Jay City U.B. Church at 2 p.m., war time, Sunday. Rev. Plumley will officiate and will be assisted by Rev. Lewis of Marion. Burial will be in the Daugherty Cemetery.
