

WIFE OF ORLANDO BRUNNER DIED EARLY THIS A.M.

Rites Friday P.M. for

Jefferson Tp. Woman - Was Ill Short Time

Mrs. Rose Marie Fairchild Brunner, 38, wife of Orlando Brunner of Jefferson township, died this morning at 3:13 o'clock at the Adams County Memorial hospital following a short illness of diabetes. It had been known to the family that she had a diabetic condition, but her condition had not been regarded as serious.

Last Sunday she suddenly became critically ill and was taken to the hospital on Monday. That evening she went into a diabetic coma.

The deceased was born in Jay county, the daughter of Robert and Luella Daugherty Fairchild. She would have been 39 on the first day of next February. Her marriage to Mr. Brunner occurred 19 years ago in October. Mr. and Mrs. Brunner and family have been residing on a farm five miles east and five miles south of Berne.

The survivors include the husband and two children, Maurice Eugene, 17, and Donna Glee, aged 11; the father and mother and the following brothers and sisters: Mrs. Ada Pyle of Jay county; Emery Fairchild of Flint, Michigan, and Miss Dora Fairchild of Jay county.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 o'clock Friday afternoon at the New Corydon Methodist church with the Rev. W. Frank Johnson officiating. Burial will be made in Gravel Hill cemetery west of Bryant.

The body will be returned to the family home late this afternoon.
