His was a shocking demise for in the best of health he left his home and family Monday morning to come to Portland on some business. He died about 5 o'clock last evening. He leaves a wife and six children - Cora Green, wife of John Green; Clara Metz, wife of Henry Metz; Ida Metzger, wife of Henry Metzger; William, Leroy and Libbie. Mrs. Ambler is a sister of Homer and Moses Gillum of this city. Mr. Ambler has lived in this part of the county for most of his life except a few years that he and his family resided in Bryant.
