

Portland Weekly Commercial, Jay County, IN; September 5, 1907

Eva M. Arbogast, wife of Henry L. Arbogast, died in the family home in S. Meridian St. shortly after 4 o'clock Saturday morning, after a lingering illness of Brights Disease. The immediate cause of death was heart failure, the attack coming on late Friday evening. During Friday, she appeared unusually well, and was able to take more than the customary amount of nourishment.

Mrs. Arbogast was the daughter of James M. and Sarah R. Powell, and was born near Zanesville, Ohio, September 14, 1869. Had she lived until her next birthday, she would have been 38 years of age. On December 1, 1890, she was united in marriage to Henry L. Arbogast. To this union, was born one daughter, Lucille, 15, who, with the husband survives.

Three sisters and five brothers, they being, Mrs. Elizabeth Gable, of Spokane, Washington; Mrs. John Iholts and Ms. Emma Powell, of the city; Richard of Lorain, Ohio; Clinton, of New York City; James P of Collett, and Will and Harl Powell, of this city are also left.
