

A. C. Allman dies following short illness.

Funeral services Saturday; Burial to be at Pennville.

Ill less than one week, Alonzo C. Allman, 89, died at 9:30 a. m. Thursday at his home, 701 Cental avenue, Union City.

Mr. Allman was born at Pennville on September 19, 1859, son of Aaron and Catherine Listenfelt Allman, and attended the Brown school near Pennville. A retired farmer and former grain elevator proprietor, he lived in the community of his birth until March 1939, at which time he moved to Union City.

He married Bethenia Wright, deceased in 1930, at Hartford City in 1879. On November 25, 1939 he was united in marriage with Mrs. Mary Lilly Hollopetter at Greenville, O.

Survivors include the widow, Mary; one daughter, Mrs. Ira Paraday, of Chicago; three brothers, William Allman, of Chicago; Theodore Allman of Indianapolis, and Thomas Allman, of Ft. Wayne, and two sisters, Irene and Elizabeth, of Dayton, O. Two sons and two daughters are deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted Saturday at 1 p. m. (CST) at the Frazee Funeral home in Union City, with Rev. L. G. Ludwick officiating. Burial will be made in the Pennville cemetery. Friends may view the remains after noon today at the Frazee Funeral home.
