

## Ft. Recovery Resident Dies

Hubert (Whitey) Sommer, 42, 271 Lowry Rd., Fort Recovery, died of cancer at 12:45 a.m. today at Ball Memorial Hospital, Muncie, Ind.

He was born June 20, 1937, in Jay County, Ind., the son of the late Earl and Lulu Fern (Warnock) Sommer. His step-mother, Luella Wolf, survives in Jay County. On Sept. 13, 1958, he was married in Fort Recovery to Patricia Nieberding, who also survives with two children, Cynthia and Charles both at home.
