25th Regiment, Tennessee Infantry

25th Infantry Regiment completed its organization in August, 1861, at Camp Zollicoffer, in Overton County, Tennessee. Its members were recruited in the counties of White, Overton, Putnam, and Jackson. The unit fought at Fishing Creek and Perryville, then was assigned to General B.R. Johnson's Brigade, Army of Tennessee. In November, 1863, it was consolidated with the 44th Regiment. The unit participated in the conflicts at Murfreesboro and Chickamauga, served in the Knoxville operations, then moved to Virginia. Here it saw action at Drewry's Bluff, took its place in the Petersburg trenches, and ended the war at Appomattox Courthouse. In January, 1862, this regiment reported 683 men present for duty, had 55 disabled at Fishing Creek, and suffered 8 casualties at Perryville. It lost thirty-six percent of the 336 at Murfreesboro and thirty-nine percent of the 145 at Chickamauga. The 25th/44th reported 95 casualties of the 259 engaged at Drewry's Bluff. On April 9, 1865, the 25th surrendered 4 officers and 21 men. The field officers were Colonels John M. Hughes and Sidney S. Stanton; Lieutenant Colonels Samuel Davis, George G. Dibrell, R.C. Sanders, Robert B. Snowden; and Majors Josiah H. Bilbrey, William A. Duncan, Samuel H. McCarver, and Timothy H. Williams.

Clark Franklin was born about 1804 in Fentress County, TN. He died some time after 1880 in Gradyville, Adair County, KY.

Clark was the son of \*Clark Franklin (1784) and \*Lula Underwood (1788).

Clark married Mary Ann "Polly" Black April 12, 1829 in Washington County, IN. Polly was the daughter of ?. She was born about 1814 in IN. She died between 1842-1848 in Fentress County, TN. After her death Clark married Mary Polly Bowden. She was the daughter of Simpson Bowden and ?. She was born about 1822 in TN. She died some time after 1880.

In 1850 Clark and his son Thomas were farmers. The family was living in Fentress County, TN. By 1860 Clark was a tailor, all of he and Polly's children had grown up and moved away. The family is still living in Fentress, County, TN. By 1870 Clark is again farming and has moved the family to Gradyville, Adair County, KY. This census states Clark was born in VA. By 1880 all the children have grown up and moved away. Clark is still farming, he is in his late seventies. This census states he and both his parents were born in VA.

Clark and Polly had six children:

Sarah Pauline Franklin born November 8, 1830 in KY, m. William Bennett Bowden 1847, died 1906.

Thomas Franklin born 1834 in IN.

Edward Franklin born December 15, 1831-1838 in TN, died November 3, 1915 of heart dropsy, in Adair County, KY. Buried at Tarter Cemetery.

Mary Franklin born about 1838.

Nathaniel Franklin born March 25, 1839 in Fentress County, TN died December 9, 1899 in Sulpur Well, Metcalfe County, KY.

John Franklin born about 1842.

Jesse Franklin born 1853 in Fentress County, TN died in Bloomington, Monroe County, IN.

Margaret Franklin born about 1855 in Fentress County, TN.

Elias Franklin

Shirley Maul of Poughkeepsie, NY provided much of the info on the Elias Franklin family.

Marriage Bond, The Commonwealth of Kentucky. Be it known that we Elias Frankling as principal, and W. C. Pickett as surety, are jointly and severally bound to the Commonwealth of Kentucky, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars. The condition of this bond is as follows: That, whereas Marriage is intended to be solemnized between the above bound Elias Frankling he hearing over 21 years of age and Miss Susan M. Kemp her Guardian being W. Pickett having given his consent in writing. Now, if there is no lawful cause to obstruct said Marriage, this Bond shall be void, otherwise it shall remain in full force and effect. Dated at Columbia, Adair County, this 9th day of August, 1870. Attest: Elias (his mark) Frankling and W. C. (his mark) Pickett.. J. W. Butler, Clerk Adair County Court.

1880 Adair Co., KY. Census: Elias Frankling age 31 TN., Margaret S. age 25 KY., Rosetta age 10, William age 8, Mary M. age 5, Emma age 1. (Elias's father born in VA., mother born in TN.). They are listed in the town of Gradyville, Adair Co, KY. Precinct 5 Sheet 4A line 35.

Elias reportedly killed himself over a perceived romance between his second wife and a friend. He murdered the friend and then himself. This happened in about 1889.

Columbia Spectator, Columbia, Adair Co, KY, 17 Jul 1888 -- On Monday of last week, Elias Franklin shot and killed James B. Brent, near Munfordsville. The circumstances are about as follows: Since the beginning of the year both parties have been working on the same farm and living in the same house, and everything seemed to run smoothly until a few weeks ago when it was whispered that Franklin's wife was too fond of Brent, who was a young unmarried man. On Saturday before the killing Franklin's wife left home and went to Metcalf County and on the day named, Franklin, with a Winchester rifle, went to the field where Brent was at work and called him to the fence where they were heard talking and laughing together for several minutes, but apparently friendly and in the best of humor. The gun was fired, the shot taking effect in the neighborhood of the heart and Brent fell at full length on his back and died without uttering a word. Franklin immediately left in the direction of Hardyville, although he did not seem to be in a hurry. His dead body was found Tuesday morning in a barn near Sulphur Well, Metcalf County where he committed suicide. Franklin went to Hart from this county several years ago. All parties were generally respected.
